## Advanced English Composition (고급영어작문)

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- When writing me an email, always include your name, student ID number, and class day and time.
- If you are using Hanmail or other Korean email services, you might have to include my email in your address book in order to receive replies

## Course Objectives and Description

This course sets out to improve English academic and business writing ability through:

- Regular writing practice
- Instructor feedback, commentary, and assistance
- Grammar, punctuation, and format instruction
- Peer feedback and discussion

This course will focus on a short essay exam and three major writing assignments: A Short Story, A Resume/Cover Letter, and an Argumentative Paper. Course materials will prepare students for each of those assignments through practice, examples, and instruction.

## Course Requirements

The grade for this class will be based on 5 items

- The Argumentative Research Paper: 25 points
- The Resume/Cover Letter: 15 points
- The Short Story:

15 points

- The Essay Exam: 15 points
- Class Participation and Attendance: 20 points
- Online Forum Participation: 10 points


## Grading

If this class has 20 students or more, grades will be curved to meet departmental grading standards: No more than $30 \%$ of students can receive an A or higher, and no more than $70 \%$ of students can receive a B or higher.

If this class has fewer than 20 students, students who receive 90 points or higher will get an A, students who receive 80 to 90 points will get a B, students who receive 70 to 80 points will get a $C$, and students who receive fewer than 70 points will get a $D$ or $F$. However, grades may be curved at the professor's discretion (generally, the grades will be curved up not down).

## Attendance and Class Participation

Each class period is worth 1 point. You can lose this point in several ways:

- If you do not attend class, you lose 1 point.
- If you are late to class, you will lose 0.2 points for every 10 minutes that you are late up to 1 point.
- If you do not participate in classroom activities, such as in-class writings or writing discussion, or if you use excessive Korean during class, do not answer questions, or generally are not actively engaged in class, you will lose 1 point.
If you have a valid reason for not attending class (such as a medical problem or job interview, please let me know in advance if possible. Bring proof of the reason for your absence to the next class that you attend.


## Cheating

You are expected to do all of your own work during class time. Cheating will result in failure of that assignment. Cheating includes (but is not limited to):

- Copying any part of any of your assignments from the internet, a book, or another person.
- Copying from another student during the exam.
- Basically, presenting any material that you did not make as your own.

I take cheating very seriously. If you aren't sure if something is cheating or not, ask me.
