Facilitation Project

Description

Students taking ENGL 629 as a doctoral seminar (ENGL 703) are expected to co-facilitate one class with Ryan. This involves choosing extra readings on a topic and preparing discussion and an activity for that class. A short reflection on the facilitation is required.

Description

As part of the Facilitation Project, you will complete the following:

- Choose a date on the schedule that has a subject interesting to you. The date you choose must be approved by Ryan in advance.
- Read 2-3 additional readings for that day to get a greater context of the subject. These can be found with Ryan's help.
- Come to class with discussion questions you have written and read the discussion posts from your fellow students in advance. Help to manage the class discussion.
- Have at least one activity for the day prepared.

Write a short (500-1000 word) reflection on your experience, including what the additional readings helped you understand on the subject and how the discussion enhanced your views.
