Basics

Remember to include various topics we have covered (or will cover) this semester, such as discourse, societal values, consciousness raising, therapy, distraction, semiotics, oppression & liberation, dominant ideologies, identity, corporate control/subversion, affect, and globalization.
- Clarify the form your final project will take. Do you plan to make a video, a slide presentation, a podcast, or a traditional paper with multimodal elements? Clarify what you will be using as evidence: video clips, still images, audio, etc.
- Submit your proposal in the Google Drive folder for this class. Your files should be named with your name, your class, and the assignment (i.e. Malcolm Reynolds ENG 3850 Final Project Proposal).
