### WP2: AI and Revision Analysis

#### Description

For WP2, you will take *either* your reflection or your remediation from WP1 and revise it one more time with the help of generative AI. You'll choose which document to revise and then document the ways in which you use AI to revise it. Please document all of the AI use in detail, including which AI clients you use, what prompts you used with the AI, what changes you chose to make based on the AI revisions, and what changes you chose not to make and why.

#### Learning Outcomes

By the end of this writing project, students will be able to:

- Further build strategies for planning and revising writing.
- Analyze the output of generative AI and evaluate the output in relation to writing.
- Integrate AI output into writing.
- Reflect critically on both AI and integration of AI output.

#### Choosing What to Revise and How

Choose whether to revise your remediation narrative or your reflection from WP1. You do not need to revise both. Choosing the remediation will allow you to use multimodal generative AI (such as Midjourney or Firefly) while choosing the reflection will allow you to focus on text-based generative AI (such as ChatGPT, Gemini, or Claude). You can use AI as you see fit to revise, but make sure to document the whole process, including:

- Which AI clients you are using
- What prompts you enter to generate output
- What output you get, including both good and bad results
- What you choose to actually use and why

## Requirements

### A New Revision

You must produce a new version of WP1 remediation or reflection. The new version must include at least some AI-generated content.

### Reflection

Because the biggest new part of WP2, it's weighted even higher than in WP1. Your reflection for WP2 is worth 75% of your grade. It must be a minimum of **1200 words** and may include multimodal elements.

### Submission

Please submit your project and reflection through Blackboard. Please approve any alternative methods to submit your writing project with me in advance.

### Due Dates

- Completion drafts are due on **Wednesday, March 18**
- Revision drafts are due on **Wednesday, March 25**

## Completion Drafts

Completion drafts are graded on demonstrating a basic understanding of the requirements. Grades for completion drafts aren't an indication of how well you'll do on the revision draft. To get full credit for the completion draft, you must do the following:

### Revise your WP1

You have chosen either your remediation or your reflection from WP1 to revise. You have produced a substantially different version of that document for WP2.

### Integrate AI Outputs

You have used AI in your revision process, integrating AI as you see fit. You have documented all AI use throughout the project.

### Reflect on your choices

Like with WP1, in WP2 your reflection is worth 50% of your grade, including for the completion drafts. In WP2, the reflection is particularly important. You must use this space to explain:

- Which AI clients you used and why you used them
- What prompts you entered to generate output and why you designed the prompts in that way
- What output you got from specific prompts, including both good and bad results
- What you chose to integrate into your new revision, why you chose that content, and how you integrated it

## Revision Drafts

Revision drafts are graded using the checklists below. If you do not check all the boxes in the C column, your project will get an F. In order to get grades in a certain column, *all* of the boxes in that column must be met.
